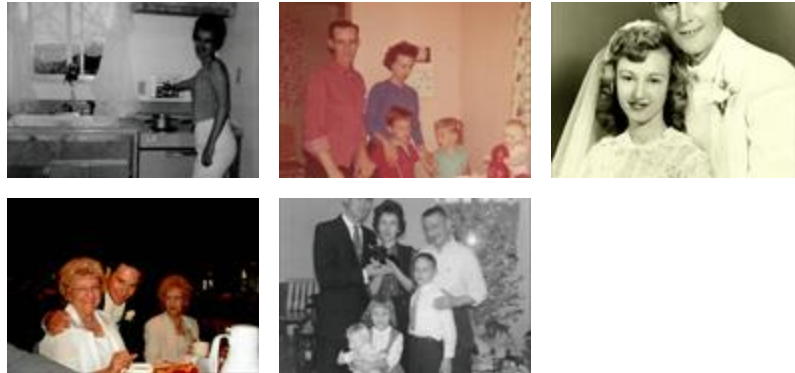
“ I always loved that Aunt Doris was so outgoing, happy, energetic and had such a love for life. The pictures are beautiful and bring back so many memories.
