On Tuesday, July 28, 2020, Russell W. "Rusty" Moore, age 56, of South Park, passed away after a long and valiant battle with multiple sclerosis. Beloved husband of Molly A. (Griffith) Moore; cherished son of the late Russell W. and Mary K. (Cleary) Moore Cano; step son of Thomas Cano; loving brother of Michele (Don) Tomlins, of Venetia, Mona (Neal) Musser, of Nottingham, and Carrie (Dale) Morgele, of Jefferson Hills; also survived by many nieces, nephews, great-nieces, great-nephews and countless friends.
